Karachi Port Receives \$50 Million Upfront Payment from AD Ports Group



KPT has received a substantial upfront payment of \$50 million from Abu Dhabi Ports Group (AD Ports). This payment is part of a new concession agreement between the two parties.

Minister of Maritime Affairs Mr. Qaiser Ahmed Sheikh, the then Federal Secretary Minister of Maritime Affairs Mr. Iram Anjum Khan, Chairman KPT Syedain Raza Zaidi and other notables have attended the august ceremony.

In his remarks during the event, Minister for Maritime Affairs, Mr. Qaiser Ahmed Sheikh, emphasized the government's unwavering commitment to the maritime sector and underscored the pivotal role of partnerships in fostering sustainable growth and development. He expressed confidence that the collaborative efforts between the two countries would yield mutual benefits, strengthening bilateral ties and contributing to the advancement of both nations.

During the signing ceremony, Chairman KPT, Syedain Raza Zaidi, expressed his gratitude and excitement for the partnership with AD Ports Group. He highlighted the transformative opportunities that this investment brings to Karachi Port, emphasizing the significance of the \$50 million contribution and the strategic alliance between KPT and AD Ports Group.

This significant investment is expected to enhance Karachi Port's efficiency and capacity, enabling it to handle larger vessels and increased cargo volumes. The funds will be utilized for infrastructure upgrades and expansion projects, further strengthening Karachi Port's position as a key maritime hub.

It is a significant achievement that has enhanced operational efficiency of the region's busiest container yard making it more safe and secure. Spanning 139 acres, TPX Container Yard receives approximately 600 containers daily, contributing significantly to national revenue. The rehabilitation initiative, covering a 5-kilometer stretch, has mitigated damages and safety concerns caused by

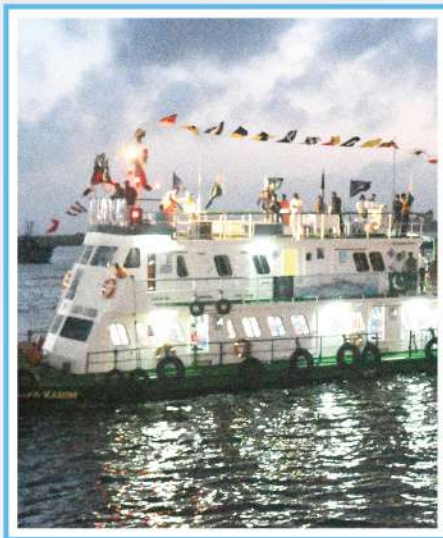
torrential rains that became source of operational disruption earlier.

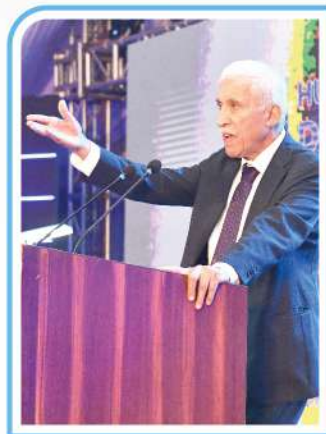
MSC ANNA, The Largest Container Vessel, Arrived at KPT

KPT proudly welcomed the historic arrival of MSC ANNA, the largest container vessel ever to docked in Pakistan on 31st May 2024, at its South Asia Pakistan Terminal Limited (SAPTL). This milestone reaffirms KPT's position as a premier Maritime Hub in the region.

With dimensions of 400 meters in length and a capacity of 19,368 TEUs, MSC ANNA exemplifies KPT's progress and strategic significance. Governor Sindh Mr. Kamran Khan Tessori commended the successful handling of the massive vessel, noting its positive impact on the country's economy.



Chairman KPT, Syedain Raza Zaidi, emphasized that Karachi Port, strategically located at the crossroads of South Asia, the Middle East, and Central Asia, serves as a vital gateway for trade in these regions. 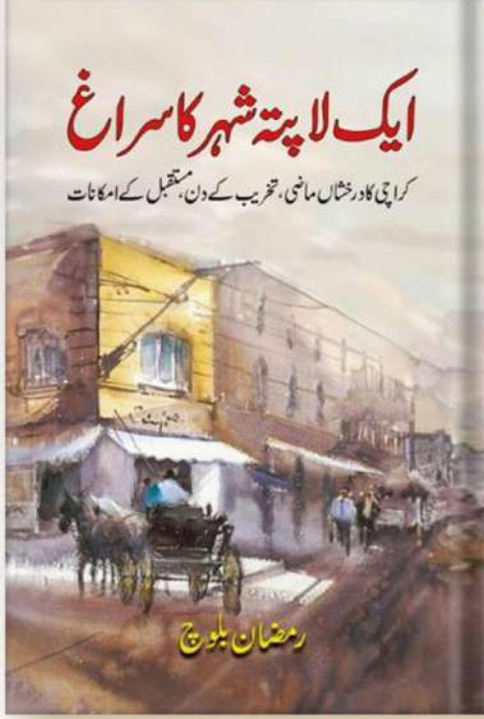
KPT Bids Farewell to Project Manager Mr. Shafi Muhammad
