KPT Celebrates the 100 Years of KPT Head Office Building



It is indeed a historical moment for Karachi Port Trust to celebrate 100 years of a well famed building of Pakistan, the KPT Head Office Building, in great fervour on 5th January 2016. The Minister for Ports and Shipping Senator Kamran Michael graced the occasion as chief guest. The proceedings started with National Anthem and followed by Guard of Honour from parade contingents. While speaking on the occasion Mr. Kamran Michael laid stress on national heritage assets of the nations and said that these belong to our next generation as well. He complemented the Chairman KPT Vice Admiral (R) Shafiq Jawad for maintaining it so well in its original shape. A meeting of Senate Standing Committee on Ports and Shipping headed by Member of National Assembly Syed Ghulam Mustafa Khan was held on 22nd February 2016 in KPT. The meeting was attended by Secretary Ports and Shipping Mr. Khalid Pervez, DG Ports and Shipping Mr. Asad Rafi Chandna besides the Chairman KPT Vice Admiral (R) Shafqat Jawed and the management officials of KPT.

Implementation of Signage – KPT EHS Team Visits PICT

The EHS team of KPT visited the PICT to observe their current practices with focus on implementation of PPEs and signage boards made by them and are presently in use by PICT. The EHS coordinators on the visit have observed

the layout plan imposed by PICT for handling logistics movement which eliminated the presence of idle trucks parked inside the terminal area. Overall observations made during the trip by EHS Coordinators are given below.

Presence of complete layout plans with drawings is seen by members of KPT EHS team during the visit. The layout plan entails separate ways for in and out bound vehicular movement which has curtailed unnecessary trucking inside the terminal area.

PICT has separate and dedicated parking area with markings and it has broadened the vision of KPT EHS Coordinator team to make implementation in the scope on similar lines.

KPT EHS team has observed presence of mobile check points which temporarily assembles to check and restrict pedestrian movement during the cargo operations and there is no parking of vehicles alongside the vessels at terminal area.

KPT EHS team noted the presence of painted road markings as part of signage markings as well as presence of prominent and visible identification marks / notices / instructions in the terminal area of PICT. It will be the KPT EHS team implementation of signage

within the scope area marked for EHS compliance by KPT Management.

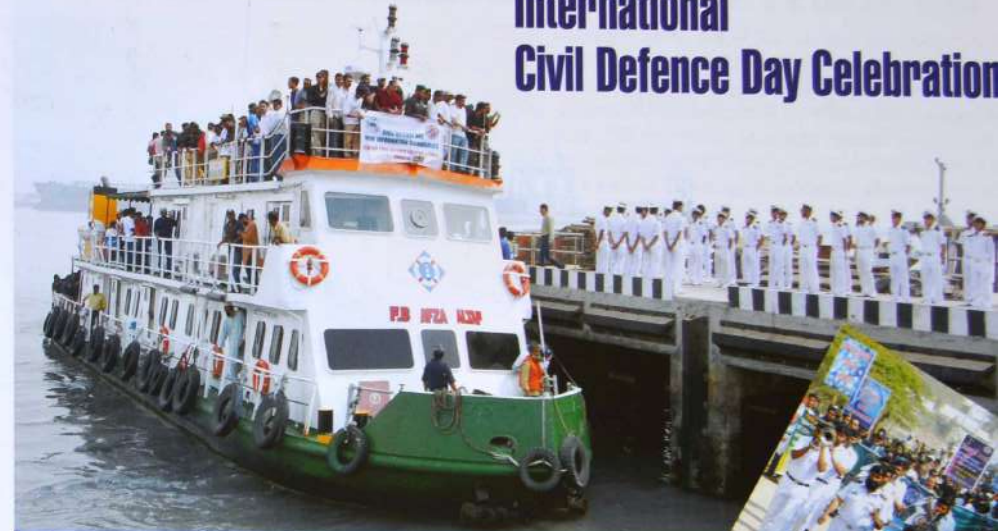
- The KPT EHS team found the site area alongside vessels as neat and clean during the ongoing cargo operations and an implementation within the scope area is expected to take place on similar lines.
- It was also noted by the EHS Coordinators during the visit that PICT is using shuttle service to curtail pedestrian movement inside the terminal area. The EHS team proposed to have a similar shuttle service inside the scope area as part of EHS implementation.
- The EHS Coordinators have also observed the strict compliance of PPE wearing inside the PICT area by both technical and non-technical staff. Besides this, it was noted that PICT regularly implements training programme for their staff under the EHS compliance and even spokesman of PICT also clarified during the visit that NOC for work permits to technical and non-technical staffs are issued on daily basis.

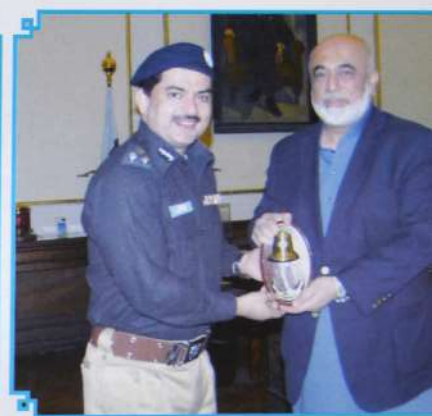

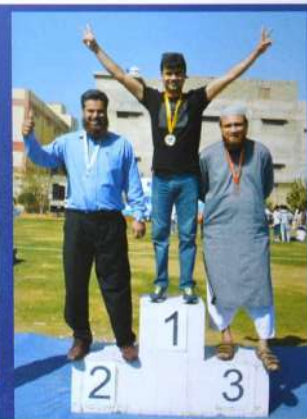
