Karachi, the 12th April, 2023

S. R. O. 522(I)/2023.—In pursuance of section 43 read with section 43-A and 43-Bnof the Karachi Port Trust Act, 1886, the Board of Trustees of the Port of Karachi hereby revise and alter Scales of Port Charges prescribed in Notification No. S.R.O I(KE)/2003 dated 7th January, 2003 to the extent given below, to be effective after thirty (30) days, after the date of publication of this notification, except Port dues, which will be applicable after sixty (60) days of publication of this notification as:

SECTION-3

In Section 3, sub-section 0305, 0314, 0315 and 0316 are amended as under:

0305: HOLIDÅY WORKING CHARGES.

'Amend 'a', 'b' and 'd' as under':-

- a. Requisition for delivery of import cargo Rs. 1500 per consignment.
- For vessel working (loading / discharging) Rs. 5000 per vessel per shift.

- '0314, 0315 are substituted as under'
- 0314: "In case of Shipping lines bringing 10% transshipment in fiscal year, 5% discount will be offered in Port dues. Subsequently for every 5% further of transshipment, 2% further discount will be offered in Port dues."
- 0315: "In case of Shipping lines bringing 10% transshipment in fiscal year, 5% discount will be offered in Berthing. Subsequently for every 5% further of transshipment, 2% further discount will be offered in Berthing charges."
- 0316: Substitute clause 0316 as under:

0316: Shifting of working vessels

- (a) A vessel berthed at deep draft berths from berth No. 10 to 17 and drawing a draft between 10.75 meters to 13 meters and utilizing the deep draft facility, one shifting will be on vessel account and the second shifting, if carried out will be on Port convenience, provided that vessel does not default on other port requirements such as idle vessel not discharging or loading as per norms defined in Traffic Manual.
- (b) If a working cargo vessel is required to be shifted from one berth to another berth due to non-availability of storage space of import or export cargo requiring covered accommodations such shifting shall be considered as shifting for Port convenience.
- (c) Whenever a vessel is required to be shifted from one berth to another berth via stream (warping) so as to accommodate another vessel or the same vessel in view of restriction of LOA, beam, draft, etc. such shifting shall be treated for Port convenience.
- (d) For every shifting or warping at the request of the vessel the shifting charges as specified in KPT Tariff shall be leviable.

Wharfage charges on FCL container(s) containing more than one consignment (of the same consignee) will be recovered by dividing the charges in the ratio of the weights of respective consignments as shown in the Bill of Lading / Customs Bill of Entry, such that the total wharfage charged is equal to the FCL container charges mentioned in Clause 0402 Item 'c'.
